

ASCIT Club Funding Policy

To receive ASCIT club funding a club must:

- Register on donut. Registration implies maintaining a website and viable contact information.

- Submit a funding proposal. The club must submit a funding proposal as outlined by the ASCIT Secretary by the set deadline. Such a proposal is to include such information as number of active members, statement of purpose, budget, and planned events as described in the current form.

- Appear at the funding meeting. All clubs must send a representative to the third term club funding meeting. At this meeting a club representative will present their proposal and answer any questions regarding the club.

Clubs will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Level of Activity. Gauged by events, consistent meetings, and term reports (beginning 08-09 funding cycle).

- Membership. Will take into account all members, but the focus is on the number of current ASCIT members.

- Benefit to the Student Body. - Clubs which have a positive impact on a larger portion of the student body will be given more weight.

ASCIT funding incurs the following stipulations:

- Termly Reports. A club is required to submit termly reports detailing the spending, activities, and current status of the club. These reports should be submitted within the first two weeks of the following term to the ASCIT Secretary.

- Timely pick up of checks. Clubs must pick up checks within two weeks of being contacted by the ASCIT Treasurer.

Failure to submit reports or pick up checks in a timely manner may result in a loss of funding.
